TRAVELLING



Be going to

We use **Be going to** to talk about plans for the future.

Affirmative		
I am You are He/She/It is We are You are They are	going to	sleep.

Negative		
I am not (I'm not) You are not (You aren't) He/She/It is not (He/She/It isn't) We are not (We aren't) You are not (You aren't) They are not (They aren't)	going to	sleep.

Interrogative		
Am I Are you Is he/she/it Are we Are you Are they	going to	sleep.

Differences between **be going to** and **will**.

We use both **will** and **be going to** to make predictions and to talk about our decisions. However, we use them in a slightly different way.

We use...	Will	Be going to
Predictions	based on our own knowledge and opinions: <i>Jack will score. He always scores in important games.</i>	based on the situation and what we can see: <i>Jack has got the ball! He is going to score!</i>
Decisions	instant decisions that we make while speaking: <i>Show me the menu. Hmm. I'll have chicken.</i>	intentions – things that we have already decided: <i>I'm going to have chicken tonight. I bought it this morning.</i>

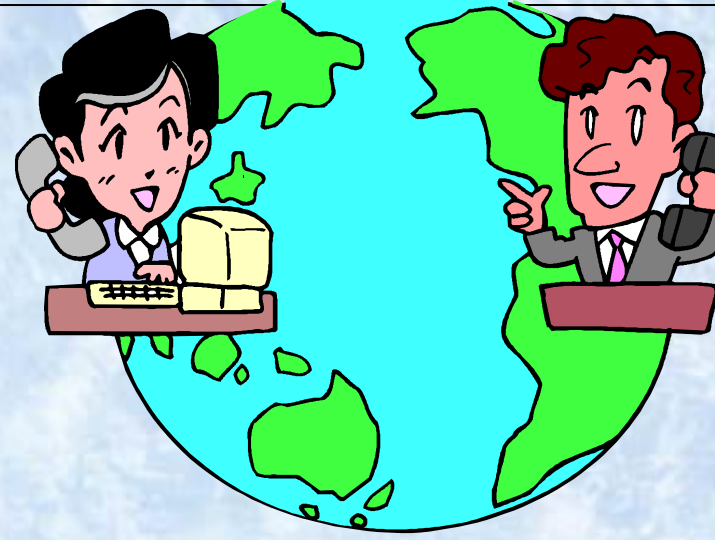

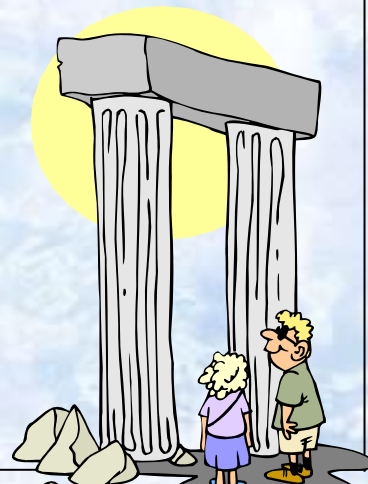

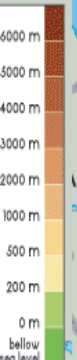
- **Work with cards.**

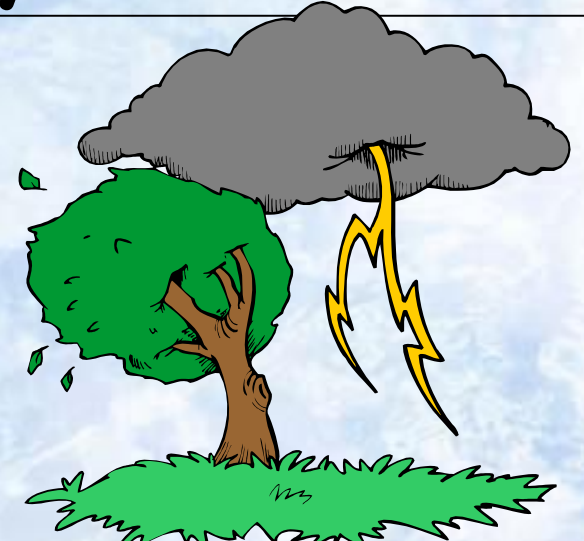

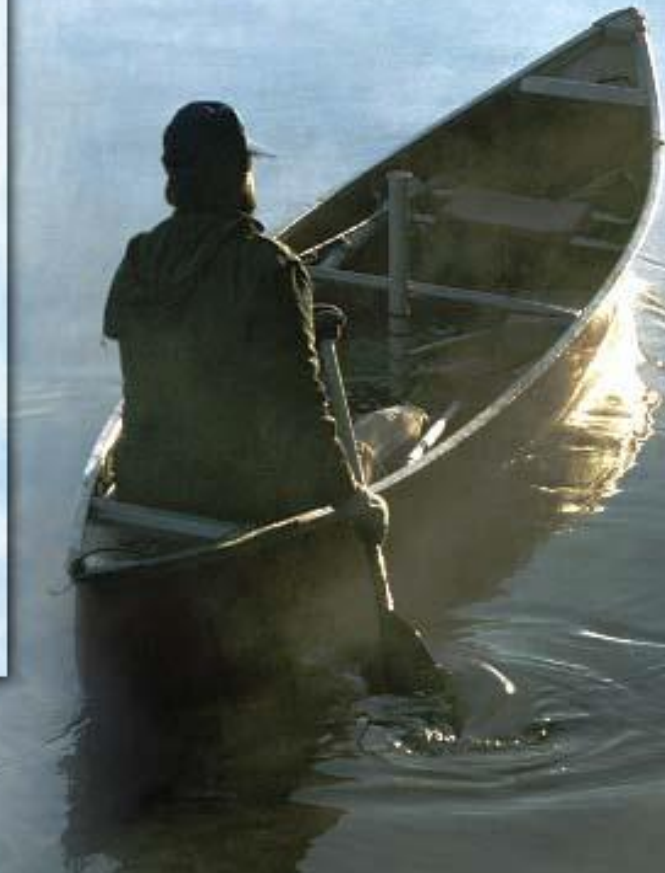
