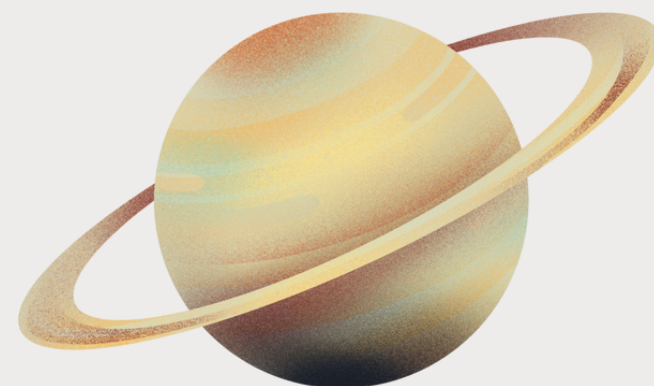

Weather

Weather refers to the atmospheric conditions at a specific place and time.

- It changes daily and includes factors like temperature, precipitation, wind, cloud cover, etc.

- Weather Factors:

- Temperature (hot, cold)

- Precipitation (rain, snow)

- Wind (speed, direction)

- Humidity

- Atmospheric Pressure

Example: The weather today is rainy with a temperature of 15°C.

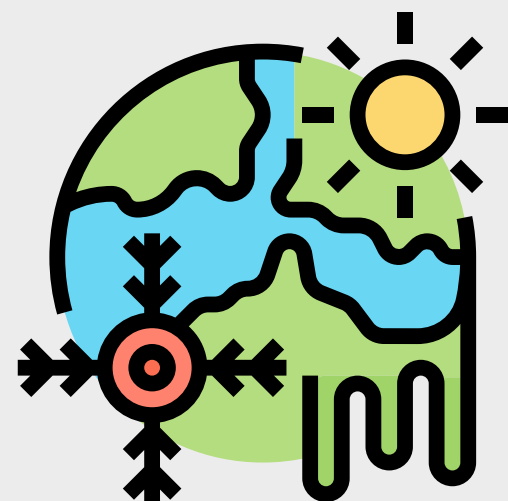


Climate

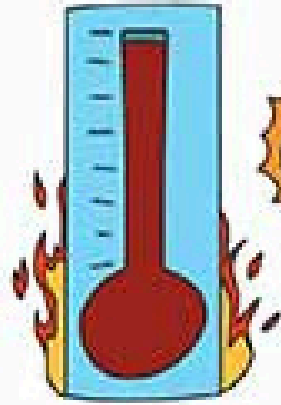
Climate refers to the average weather conditions in a region over a long period (usually 30 years).

- Climate is influenced by factors like latitude, elevation, and geography.
- Climate Zones:
- Tropical Climate
- Temperate Climate
- Arid Climate
- Polar Climate
- Subarctic Climate

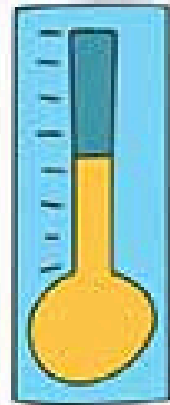
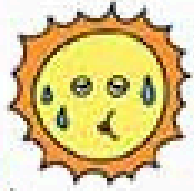
Example: The climate in Kazakhstan is continental.



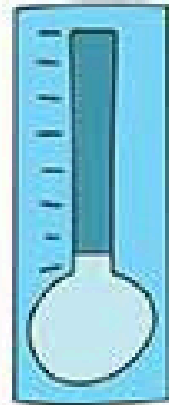
